In April 1986, I came home from work to find my wife excited about a phone call she had received from an 80 year old man in Charlotte NC wanting me to call him back about the TERRELL SOCIETY.

When I returned his call, I was intrigued by his excitement and enthusiasm. This 80 year old man sounded like a sixteen year old boy who had just discovered girls. He not only wanted to join the TERREIL SOCIETY; he also wanted to know what he could do to help the SOCIETY grow!

I must admit that I thought I was humoring an old man when I gave him the harmless title of Correspondence Secretary and asked him to help me respond to the new inquiries we received about the SOCIETY.

That turned out to be the best decision I have made since we formed the TERRELL SOCIETY.

He not only responded with form letters as I had been forced to do with my limited time; but he went the second mile and included personalized notes to those who lived in areas where he had lived and worked as well as to those who had other surname ancestry that he shared. In addition, he followed up with numerous phone calls AT HIS OWN EXPENSE. As Bill TERRELL said in his letter to you, on Sept. 26, "Lawrence had a way of enticing all of us to do constructive things that we wouldn't ordinarily do. His enthusiasm was infectious, and his phone calls and letters were always welcome." Most of us had come to know him well and to love him deeply as a TERRELL cousin even though some of us could not prove connection between our known line and his.

Lawrence is directly responsible for: locating the Gen. William Henry Harrison TERRELL book; formation and activities of the Advisory Committee; the formation of several committees (none of which have matured to activity) to help further the goals of the SOCIETY; the forming of the LENDING LIBRARY including locating and obtaining permission to copy many of the books; and the addition of at least 100 members to our membership rolls.

This mentally alert octagenerian had to put LENDING LIBRARY books into canvas shopping bags to take them to the post office for mailing. He had to carry them by moving the bags a short distance, taking 2 or 3 short steps, moving the bags again and repeating the process. This was due losing the use of his knees, but it did not put a damper on either his enthusiasm or his willingness to serve you, our member.

He was successful in persuading Mrs. Pat Terrell Walker to assist him as correspondence secretary and finally to take over the chore of copying and mailing LENDING LIBRARY books.

As Paul HARVEY says, 'The rest of the story' is that this gentleman's last ancestor who had the TERRELL surname was Barbara Overton TERRELL (1756-1798) who md. 1773 to Aaron FONTAINE (1753-1823).

For those of us who are decades younger and many generations closer to TERRELL (or variant) ancestors to fail to keep up the momentum generated by Lawrence would be a disservice to his memory and to that of our own ancestors.



WILLIAM TERRELL MOVES TO SC

Submitted by #252 Mr. Robert F. Davidson Jr.

From the Council Journal, Province of South Carolina at Charleston, February 2, 1737/38

Read the petition of William TERRELL praying a warrant for 200 acres of land in the Queensborough or the Welch Tract having sworn his right. Petition granted.

This gives the arrival of William TERRELL in SC and his petition indicates a wife and 2 children at 50 acres per person. Unfortunately, it does not say where he came from. The land granted was in the Welch Tract (now Marlboro Co.), but there is every indication that William TERRELL was not Welch, but from Virginia or England. If we ever find a record of a William TERRELL born about 1710, who married Anne about 1732-33, maybe we can place him. His death in 1784 is recorded in the

minutes of the Welch Neck church. This will be of interest to all who descend from the TERRELLS of Marlboro County SC (which includes all the TERRALLS)—many are subscribers.

TERRELL LAND GRANTS IN GEORGIA

The following TERRELL Variations appear in INDEX OF THE HEADRIGHT AND BOUNTY GRANTS OF GEORGIA 1756-1909. The appearance of multiple grants to the same name does not prove that the grants were made to the same person.

Excerpts from A GENEALOGICAL HISTORY OF THE TYR-RELLS by J. H. TYRRELL, 1904

ORIGIN

The Founder of this Family, known as de Tirel, Tiril, Tyrol, Tyrell, and Tyrrell (with other variations in orthography) was Ralf, Sire de Tirel, de Poix, and de Gueranville, son of Walter I., Count of Vexin and Amiens. Ralf de Tirel was directly descended through his grand parents from Pepin Le Gros, Duke of Brabant, grandfather of Charlemagne, and consequently from Antenor, King of Cimmerians who lived c. BC 443.

NAME

There are several theories as to the origin of the surname, but as Ralf aforenamed, was Sire de Tirel (a small place on the north bank of the Seine, a few miles below Paris, in the French Vexin) it would appear that he adopted the place name of his Lordship as a surname.

The ancient village of Tirel is now known as Triel, a mere transposition of two letters.

Lower, F.S.A., considers that a personal name derived from "Thorold" a name in vogue on the Continent during the tenth century.

Shirley gives the origin as from "Tourelle," i. c., a small tower or eastle.

Some conjecture that it is a development of the Norse name of "Turl"; others suggest it is derived from the French "tireur" as indicating skill with the bow.

Again, 'terail' in old French, means a mound of earth, or elevated entrenchment, and as the bank of the Seine at Triel is commanded by such an eminence, some two hundred and fifty feet high, it is reasonable to suppose that the place was so named on that account, and that, as previously stated, Ralf took the place name for his surname.

It is hardly material as to how this surname arose, the fact remaining that there have been "Tyrrells" for nearly a thousand years.

ARMS

Armoral bearing were probably assumed by Ralf, Sire de Tirel, about a.d. 970 for the device of his son Hiduin was a shield "Vair." [blue & white]

Walter (I) deTirel who came into England with the Conqueror, also bore "Vair," [blue & white] as did his son and grandson.

The latter being present at the siege of Jerusalem in 1096, changed his arms to those of Poix; vize-"Gules [red], a bend argent [white or silver], between six cross crosslets fitchee at the foot, or [gold]; three and three," in order to distinguish himself from his kinsman, the Sire de Tirel who was also at Jerusalem, and who bore "Vair." [blue & white]

Sir Hugh Tyrrell, born about 1150, bore "Vair [blue & white], on a chief [across the top] gules [red], a demi lion rampant [half a lion creet, forefeet attacking], or [gold]," and on succeeding to Poix in 1171 became entitled to wear the "Poix" arms.

Sometime after the conquest of Ireland the following arms were adopted "Gules [red shield] two bars ermine [white with black triangles], between seven crosses pattees or [gold], three and one; on a chief [across the top] argent [white or silver] a demilion rampant [half ... lion creet, forefeet attacking] gules [red]." (Harleian MSS, 4036)

It has been suggested that the ermine [white with black triangles] bars on a field gules [red shield] were adopted upon the alliance of Richard (Ruadh) Tyrrell, second baron of Castleknock, with the daughter of John de Nogent, who bore a similar device; and this coat, with modifications, is borne by all the Irish branches of the Tyrrell family to this day.

The Blazon of the various coats will be found in the Roll of Arms, at the end of this Book.

Tradition avers that the seven crosses in the arms are emblematical of the seven members of the Family who took part in the Third Crusade, but only six can be identified.

The various branches in Ireland made certain changes in the tinctures and numbers of the charges (probably by way of "difference"). The demi lion of Castleknock being "gules" [red]--Fertullagh and Athboy, "azure" [blue]--Caverston and Clonmoyle, "sable." The Clonard line dropped the "chief" entirely; and in some cases the numbers of the crosses vary, but usually remain at seven.

Joseph Tyrrell of Workington (1757), or his father, Edward, deleted one cross from the second row, for what reason cannot be determined; possibly to denote the founding of an English branch of an Irish family.

There is an ancient tradition that Sir Walter (III) Tyrrell bore a complete lion, and that King Henry I cut it in two as a mark of his displeasure at Walter's flight after the death of William II, but, being finally convinced that he had no part in the death of Rufus, gave him our motto, "Veritas via vitae."

So far as the halving of the lion is concerned the tradition may be erroneous, as Walter (HI) is known only to have borne the arms of Poix and the ancient "vair," [blue & white] but as his grandson, Hugh, bore a demi lion it may be that the legend has some truth in it, although it is now practically certain that Walter was not guilty of the King's death.

It will be seen however, that the arms have undergone but little change since A.D. 1200.

CREST

There is no record as to the date when the crest, "a demi lion rampant" was first assumed, but we find it stated to have been borne by Hugh, Fourth Baron of Castleknock, who was living in the fourteenth century.

There has been no variation in its form, but the Castleknock, Clonmoyle, Athboy, Dublin, and Grange Castle lines tineture it "gules [red]," Fertuliagh and Clonard, "azure," [blue] and Caverston "proper" [natural colors].

[EDITORS' NOTE: It is odd that he missed the other Tyrrell crest—the one used on our binder. 'A boar's heads couped and creet issuant out of the mouth a peacock's tail proper.' In other words a white boar's head cut off at the neck, placed upright, with a natural looking peacock's tail sticking out of its mouth.]

MOTTO

"Veritas via Vitae"--Used prior to 1486, and according to tradition since 1100.

The mottoes of the English branches were and are as follows: Tyrrell of Heron, Essex, "Sans dieu rien." Tyrrell of Gipping, Essex, "Tout pour ic mieux." Tyrrell of Borcham, Essex, "Sans crainte."

STANDARD

"The cross of St. George; gules [red], a tiger proper [natural color and likeness], and five escollops [new moons] argent [white or silver]. The motto on a double scroll, the fringe compony argent [white or silver] and gules [red]." The records do not give the tinetures; but following the prevailing use, they would have been as stated.

TO BE CONTINUED

[EDITOR'S NOTE: heraldry is explained in more detail with illustrations on pages 154,155, 180-184, 202-206. On page 183, Vair is #39C and Ermine is 39A. The reference to bar is to a horizontal strip across the shield colored like ermine.]

J. H. TYRRELL'S CHALLENGE

Joseph H. Tyrrell also wrote the following in the previously quoted book:

"Thave taken these pains, not for the present age, but for a future. Many things known to our Grand Sires are lost to us, and our Grand Children will search in vain for many facts that are to us so familiar."

"Several years have been occupied in collecting the following Records; and although, in parts, the result is meager, yet it should not be forgotten that owing to the scanty records remaining, of Irish families, the labor has been far greater than it would appear. It is to be hoped that those who come after, will in their turn set down such Family History as they may be able to collect, and so carry on the Story of this ancient House to the end of time."

He wrote that challenge in December 1904, long before either the Terrell Society of America or the Tyrrell Family History Association of England was envisioned.

ARKANSAS AERIAL PHOTOS AVAILABLE

Acrial photos of areas in Arkansas are available from: Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Dept.; Photogrammetry; P O Box 2261; Little Rock AR 72201. Cost is \$11.00 per square foot of photo paper; additional copies of same photo made at the same time are \$5.50 per square foot. Enlargements can be made up to 20 times the original photo and can be as large as 40 x 40 inches. [roughly \$122.00 for the largest photo available and half that for additional prints at the same time.]

To order, you need to point out the exact location on a standard county map. The highway department can then make a print of the photo containing your area and will mark it showing exactly the area you want reproduced. A contact print of a 9" x 9" negative covers about 8 1/2 square miles of land. A 4 times enlargement will make roads, yards, and houses easy to distinguish.

For genealogical purposes, you could find out if there are any cemeteries in the immediate area that are not readily visible from the roads. The exact location in relation to roads, creeks, bridges, etc. would be pinpointed for you.

Besides genealogical research, aerial photos framed and matted would make wonderful gifts. A photo of the area of an old home place, home town, or family cemetery would make an interesting conversation piece at a family reunion and could be included in a family history book.

DOCTOR INFORMATION

The American Medical Assn. will research their DECEASED PHYSICIAN MASTERFILE for information about a particular doctor. Cost is \$15.00 per name and prepayment is required.

Most records commence in earnest about 1906 although they were keeping records in the late 1800's, records prior to 1906 are incomplete.

Files from 1906 onward include all medical doctors licensed to practice in the United States regardless of whether or not they were members off the AMA. Files are limited to medical doctors and do not include dentists, podiatrists, etc. The earliest resource available is 1878.

They do not research surnames. They will look up any doctor for whom a complete name (or at least a first and last name) is given along with the time period during which the doctor practiced and the location (if known).

The files do not include any information on the family, survivors, etc. They have date of birth, death, places of practice, medical schools attended, etc. They also provide a list of other organizations to contact for further information. If an obituary was published in the Journal of the AMA (JAMA) a copy will be included.

[Editor's note: Counties in GA, and probably elsewhere, maintain a PHYSICIAN'S REGISTER, usually in the vault of the Clerk of Circuit Court. In Grady County, GA, early records include date and place of birth, later records consist only of photocopy of certificate(s) from medical school(s). Never overlook your local sources!]

OKLAHOMA VITAL STATICS

Department of Health; Division of Vital Records; 1000 NE 10th St.; P O Box 53551; Oklahoma City OK 73152; 1-405-271-4040 is the place. \$5.00 is the price for either birth or death.

Begun in 1908, mandatory after 1940; neither on microfilm nor on computer; alphabetical master index in bound volumes helps locate persons. Individual records are filed first by name, then by county, then by date of death. All searches must be done manually by department personnel.

A letter is sufficient to request a death certificate. It should include full name, date and place of death, and if known any other helpful information such as funeral director, parents names, etc. The more common the given and surname, the greater the need for supplemental information.

Almost anyone, not even a relative, can request death certificates; Birth certificates are available only to the person himself, or to very close relatives [parents in the case of minors, children in the case of elderly, etc].

UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA SENIOR TO TACKLE MT. EVEREST

Joseph Dinnan, 22 Will Lead 10 Climbers up East Face in 1988

Athens GA--The University of Georgia senior music and anthropology student is preparing to tackle the mountain climber's ultimate challenge. He will lead an expedition of 10 climbers up the cast face of Mt. Everest--if \$250,000 can be raised.

He has received sponsorship; from the university, which is helping to find corporate backing. UGA will send two researchers, Dr. Harry DUVAL and Dr. Rodney DISHMAN to study the effects of high altitude and stress on the climbers' physical and psycological functions.

DINNAN is carefully choosing his colleagues. "It's got to be people you trust with your life and people who have had substantial Alpine climbing experience.

He has chosen 4 climbers: Dr. Ernest FOKES, an Altanta neurosurgeon who is an expert in high altitude medicine; Hank HOLDERFIELD of Decatur, GA, and instructor in high-altitude mountaineering; Steve FOISY of Athens GA, an expert in mountaineering photography and rescue techniques; and Richard TYRELL of Marietta GA, a climber with experience in the Andes and the Alps.

Tempratures for the climb are expected to be between zero and 40 below. Southern climbers practice for such conditions by climbing frozen waterfalls in the North Georgia and North Carolina mountains.

A practice climb of Mt. McKinley in Alaska is planned for summer 1987. It will be followed by a pre-climb trip to China.
