## GENEALOGY? ASK DAN!

**Q.** My maternal grandmother was **Lucy Ann TERRELL** b. 11/23/1867; d. 02/06/1955. My great grandmother was **Mary Harris [HARRIS?] TERRELL** possibly born in Campbell or Goochland Co. VA ca. 1845/47. I wonder if by chance you have any info that could tie into the above named ladies. **GTP, Baltimore**

**A.** First, a bit of constructive criticism; I sincerely hope you will take it in the spirit that it is intended.

When asking genealogical questions, it is helpful to type SUR-  
NAMES (especially MAIDEN) in ALL CAPITALS with other  
names only capitalized as in the above paragraph. Since your  
note was entirely in capitals, I am not sure whether your great  
grandmother had TERRELL as her maiden name, or whether  
she was Mary HARRIS and married a TERRELL. If the latter  
is true her name should be typed as Mary HARRIS Terrell.

Your note was on a postcard. Although this saves you a few cents  
postage, it handicaps your reader/fellow researcher. You did not  
have space to include when, where, and whom these ladies  
married. You could not include a stamped self-addressed en-  
velope with your postcard. This breaks the first rule of courtesy  
when requesting information. ALWAYS include a self ad-  
dressed-stamped envelope if you expect a personal reply.

Including a "P.S." to "pick up any expenses you may incur," is  
risky. An unscrupulous researcher could spend hours or days  
trying to answer your question--then send you a bill for \$25.00  
(more or less) per hour for the time spent regardless of whether  
he answered your question. In that case your alternatives would  
be either to pay or to spend a similar amount to get an attorney  
to try to prove that your card with "P.S." was not a binding  
contract. I never give anyone a blank check. I would have at least  
set a specific dollar limit on the "expenses" as "up to \$25.00 in  
expenses." [Nothing in this column is intended as legal advice]

even though it may address legal aspects of genealogy. See your attorney for that. dfb]

In response to your specific question, the TERRELL SOCIETY of AMERICA, INC. is a totally volunteer non-profit organization that is dedicated to collecting and spreading information about those whose name is any possible variation of TERRELL.

These variations may be made by using either double or single "r" & "l", inserting silent "h" or "w", with or without silent "e" on the end and by substituting any vowel or "y" for the "e" inside the name. There are more than 40 known variations of the name including Terrald. The most common in the USA are TERRELL, TERRILL, TARREL, TYRRELL, & THERELL.

Including this issue, we have published almost 700 pages of TERRELL specific information in our quarterly publication TERRELL TRAILS including a 62 page index for the first 426 pages. An additional index is planned at the end of Vol X in 1994.

The first rule of research after exhausting immediate family, Bible, and personal information is to try to use previous research. This includes anything that has been published about members of the surname in which you are interested. In your case that would be TERRELL and possibly HARRIS.

I found the following possibilities in the indexed portion of TERRELL TRAILS.

On pages 137-138, one **Lucinda (Aunt Lucy) TERRELL** md. one **James WARNER**, date unknown. She is listed as born in Ohio 12/15/1839; d. 08/10/1913 and buried in Highland Cemetery, Eddyville, Wapello Co. Iowa. She was dau. of **Hiram** and **Elizabeth CROSSING TERRELL**. She was granddaughter of **Timothy** and **Elizabeth NIXON TERRELL**; great granddaughter of **Matthew** and **Mary HUGHES TERRELL/TERREL** of what is now Harrison Co. West VA. Some more of her TERRELL relatives appear in charts on pages 141-142. If your estimate of your great grandmother's birth date is correct, this Lucy is too old to be your grandmother and is included here merely as an example of the necessity for checking information to determine whether it applies to your situation.

On page 384, one **Lucy Ann TERRELL** was second wife of one **William TEMPLE** (1829-1899) of Ohio. The information there is a family chart with no further information about her.

On page 264, the 1850 census listing shows one **Lucy A. TERRELL** in Haywood Co. TN household #507; a **Lucinda TERRELL** in household #435; a **Lucy TERRELL** in Orleans Parish LA household #187; another in Hanover Co. VA household #361; and a third in Madison Co. AL household #470. No further information about any of these on that page.

There are over one hundred listings in the same index containing the name "Mary" and TERRELL. However, no listing was found for a Mary HARRIS Terrell.

Page 191 contains two listings for **Lucy TERRILL** but both were heads of household in 1840 census and probably not yours.

Page 366 contains one **Lucy TIRRELL** who was christened in London Co. England in 1862. Page 365 contains three variations of Lucy in London Co. England between the 1500's and the 1800's but obviously none of these are yours either.

No Mary HARRIS is listed in the first index to TRAILS.

In addition to materials published in *TERRELL TRAILS*, the TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC. operates a **LENDING LIBRARY** containing over 30 books that contain substantial TERRELL information as well as other related lines. These books are available from Mrs. Pat T. Walker at the address on the front of this issue of TRAILS.

Each book requires a deposit equal to the cost of replacing the book in the event it is not returned. The book may be kept up to three weeks and all the deposit except \$5.00 will be returned. An additional Shipping & Handling charge is applied to each order and is not refundable.

Those most likely to contain references to your ancestors are:

#85, *GENEALOGY-TERRELL-WILLIS-KISTNER-MEIER-HARRIS* by **Helen MEIER Smith**; 220 pages; indexed; \$25.00 plus \$4.00 shipping.

#13 *TERRELL GENEALOGY* by **Emma Dicken**; 320 pages; excellent index; \$22.00 plus \$4.00 shipping.

#168 *GENEALOGY OF THE RUSH FAMILY OF VIRGINIA AND TERRELL GENEALOGY* by **Nellie F. AYRES**; 1946; 150 pages; \$22.00 plus \$4.00 shipping.

Other published materials pertaining to TERRELL (and HARRIS, if applicable) surname are available through the Family History Library of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints (Mormon). These should be available to you in the Baltimore area and further information about access to them only a phone call away. You do not have to be a Mormon to use their facilities or to share your research findings with them.

In the event that this route is not successful, an alternative route is to search the census, court, and vital statistic (if applicable) records for the area and period when you believe your ancestors were living.

The 1850 census for the counties in Virginia where you believe your great grandmother lived lists all persons living in the household. If she was Mary HARRIS, a check of the HARRIS families will probably yield several Marys. A check of the 1860 census for the same counties may narrow the possibilities.

Checking marriage records for those counties (and other probable counties) may reveal a marriage bond. The name(s) of the person(s) going on her marriage bond may narrow the search.

If you know where she died and the death date was after 1900, there is a chance that a death certificate exists. The longer it was after 1900, the better the chance. Death certificates contain names of parents of the deceased. Unfortunately, the information on the certificate is given by someone other than the deceased and may or may not be correct.

If these suggestions prove unfruitful, the last resort is to hire a professional researcher.

In any case, regardless of whether you find the information you seek, as a descendant of these TERRELL ladies, you are eligible to join the TERRELL SOCIETY OF AMERICA, INC. and we would like to have you as a member.

Q. Is the person who made the entry regarding **Moses TERRELL** during his sojourn in Franklin Co. GA connected to him or is this just an addition of general interest? PJA CA

A. **Jerry S. Barrington**; Rt 4 Box 47; Tallassee AL 36078 was on a list of professional researchers who work the state archives in Montgomery AL. I wrote to him in 1984/85 regarding some of my lost cousins whom I thought might be in the Tallassee area. The bit about **Moses TERRELL** was included in the response. Apparently he had some done work in Franklin Co. GA and for some reason the bit about **Moses TERRELL** was retained. Unfortunately, I have no idea what (if any) connection exists between the researcher and persons who passed through that area.

On page 167, there is one **Alonzo TERRELL** in New York Co. NY #180 New York City 4th Ward 1830 census.

The first is probably the same as the **Alonzo C. TERRELL** on page 285 of *TERRELL GENEALOGY* by Emma Dicken. The latter is obviously an earlier **Alonzo TERRELL** that may or may not be connected with either of the other **Alonzo TERRELLs** above.

Page 269 shows: **Alonzo TERRILL** Plymouth Co. MA household #072 in Scituate township in 1850 census; **Alonzo E. TERRILL** in Coos Co. NH household #037 Stewartstown precinct in 1850 census (same appears as **TIRRILL** on page 271); and **Alonzo P. TERRILL** in Lorrain Co. OH #391 Ridgeville Township in 1850 census. **Alonzo** may be an unusual name, but the horizon is definitely widening. dff]

### TERRELL/CHILES UPDATE

*[Editor's Note: This article contains later research than that published on page 680 and proves that some incorrect assumptions were made in the former article, TERRELL/CHILES LINES. Editors never have enough time to personally review the research connected with articles. For this reason, errors are*

perpetuated without intent. It is always a pleasure to publish a well documented update. Please turn to page 680 of your issue of *TRAILS* and write "See page # 704" in the TOP LEFT margin.]

**Micajah CHILES** was not a son of **John CHILES**. He was son of John's half-brother **Henry CHILES** and **Mary WINSTON Chiles**. This is proven by the will of Micajah's son **John CHILES** (*Richmond Co. NC Records* page 51).

John's will was proved in Richmond Court April 1786 and states in part: "Will of **John CHILES** of Richmond Co.; low in health; my brother **Micajah CHILES** and his heirs one = half estate; other half to **James, Elizabeth** and **Lydia CHILES**, children of my brother **James CHILES**, dec'd., and **Thomas CHILES** of Montgomery County. ALSO THAT PART OF MY GRANDFATHER, **Henry CHILES**, dec'd. estate that fell to me by heirship and by purchase that I made of the Said **Henry CHILES** estate of my BROTHERS, **Micajah CHILES**, **James CHILES**, . . . etc." This will leaves no doubt that **John's father, Micajah** was a son of **Henry CHILES**.

The wife of **Micajah CHILES Sr.** was **Mary TERRELL**, daughter of **Joel TERRELL Sr.** Court records prove that their children were: **Henry, William, John, Micajah Jr.,** and **James.**

*Caroline County VA Court Order Books 1746-1754* contain guardian appointments for: **William** who chose **David TERRELL** (Pg. 84, 06/10/1748); **John** who chose **Henry TERRELL** (Pg. 157 06/09/1749); **Micajah Jr.** who chose **David TERRELL** (Pg. 216 05/11/1750); and "**James CHILES**, orphan of **Micajah CHILES** makes choice of **Henry TERRELL** to be his guardian" (Pg. 253, 05/10/1751).

**Henry CHILES**, son of **Micajah Sr. & Mary TERRELL CHILES**, was probably their oldest child as no guardian appointment was found for him. His will (*Lunenburg Co. VA 1756*) named his grandmother as **Mary HOWLE**, and a 1771 court record mentions a payment to his mother **Mary MILLS**. (NOTE: After the death of **Micajah's father, Henry CHILES**, **Micajah's Mother Mary WINSTON Chiles** married a man named **HOWLE**, possibly **Robert HOWLE**; after the death of **Micajah CHILES, Sr.**, his widow, **Mary TERRELL Chiles**, married **Matthew MILLS**.)

**Manoah CHILES** was not a son of **Micajah, Sr.** but was his brother, a son of **Henry & Mary WINSTON CHILES (HOWLE)**. See Quaker Cedar Creek Monthly Meeting minutes of his marriage record which says, "Whereas **Manoah CHILES**, son of **Henry**, dec'd, of the county of **Hanover**, and **Anne CHEADLE**, daughter of **John CHEADLE . . . etc.**" (Vol 6, Virginia, pg. 233, *Encyclopedia of American Quaker Genealogy* by **W. W. HINSHAW**)

This researcher has found no proof that **Thomas CHILES** and **Sally CHILES** were children of **Micajah, Sr.** and **Mary TERRELL CHILES (HOWLE)**. If anyone has such proof, (Not Mr. **Cridlin's** article) please send it to me.

**Ann CHILES** (md. **Henry TERRELL**) and **Agatha CHILES** (md. **David TERRELL**), are also thought to be sisters (not daughters) of **Micajah CHILES Sr.** **Micajah** died 1734, at a young age, not much over 30 years, if that. **Henry TERRELL Jr.**, son of **Henry** and **Ann CHILES TERRELL** was born 01/29/1735. **David** and **Agatha CHILES TERRELL's** son, **Micajah TERRELL** md. in 1754 so he must have been born by 1733 or earlier. **Ann** and **Agatha CHILES** could not have been daughters of **Micajah CHILES**, but were more likely his sisters, children of **Micajah** and **Mary WINSTON CHILES (HOWLE)**. **Henry** and **Mary** had another son named **Malichi CHILES** as shown by a deed in 1765 in **Orange Co. VA** in which **Mary HOWLE** gives certain slaves left to her by **Henry CHILES**, then her husband to her son **Malichi CHILES**.

The only proven data I have is that he came from KY to IN before 1820 and was scalped by Indians about 1828. His will was proved 12/10/1828 in Lawrence Co. IN naming wife, Sarah, and children: Edward; Joseph; Polly; Phebe; Robert; William and Jane.

Marriage records in Madison Co. KY indicate Edward TERRILL md. Sary STEPHENSON 03/25/1794.

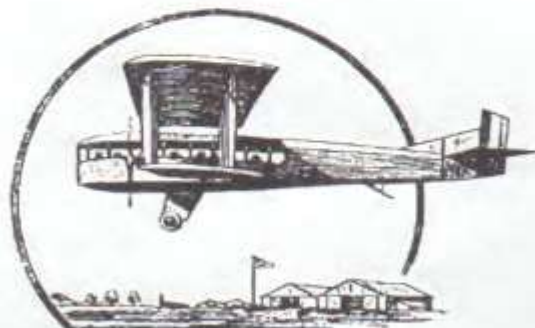
1810 census for Madison Co. KY shows Edmund TERRILL had free white males: 3 age 0-9; 1 age 10-15; and 1 age 26-44. He had free white females: 3 age 0-9; and 1 age 26-44. He had one slave.

1820 census for Lawrence Co. IN shows Edmond TERRILL had free white males: 2 age 10-15; 1 age 18-25; and 1 over 45. He had free white females: 1 age 10-15; 2 age 16-25; and 1 over 45. No slaves.

The same census shows **William TERRILL** had one free white male age 18-25 and one free white female age 16-25. No slaves.

In the same census **Nancy TERRILL** had one free white male age 16-17 and two ages 18-25. She had one free white female age 10-15 and one over 45. No slaves.

In the same census, **John TERRILL** had one free white male age 18-25; one free white female age 0-9, and one age 16-25. No slaves.

The letters reproduced on pages 714 & 715 were submitted by Member #16 whose ancestral chart appears on page 713. These letters are by and about TERRELL descendants. Even though these may not be your specific ancestors or relatives, I believe you will find them interesting. Both are filled with colorful descriptions of the era between 1840 and 1930.

OUR MOTHER'S GRANDFATHER

Coshen, Indiana, Dec. 13, 1930

Dear Brother Henry!

I am well. Hope you are, having nothing to do I get very lonely, and my mind wanders back over old times and some things got dim so I can't get them untangled in my mind and will keep pondering over them. But if I had someone to talk to about it would soon pass away. I use to write to Amanda and was just thinking of writing again to her and ask her and just then I got a letter that she was sick but was improving. I also got a letter from Etile Iyerla wishing me to send her a record of her Mother's family. I told her that old record was once with Lem and for her to see if he yet had it. Maybe Lem left it with the children at Marion, Illinois. Since then I thought of writing to you and give as much knowledge as I can remember, so I will begin with our ~~father's~~ Grandfather.

He was of Virginia and of a very aristocratic family and owned some slaves. Moved to Raleigh, North Carolina. His son, our ~~grand~~ father was of same nature as of his father. You may remember our father always cautioned us not to go on notes as security. Our Grandfather once had slaves, but being of kind heart he lost them by going surety for people, and his children had to work for their living and all of them lived honorable lives. I will try to name them: (1) Solomon, (2) Henry Macon (our father), (3) William, (4) Lemuel, (5) Thomas, (6) Samuel, (7) Benjamin, (8) Mary, (9) Amelia, (10) Cathelin, is all I can remember now.

We will go back and try to follow our father. He first learned carriage making in Greensboro, North Carolina. I should have told you he was born March 30, 1809, Henry Macon Cooke. Sometime after he learned his trade, he started west, stopped at Marietta, Georgia and worked there awhile. I have heard him tell of the falling star he saw one night while on a trip West (he had to up with home trouble) that was on November 13, 1833. Why I remember it so well is we had that date set for our wedding, November 13, 1870, but changed it to November 20, 1870.

We next hear of him at Wetumpka, Alabama.

Now we will go look for Mother near Lexington, Kentucky. Her father was Samuel (I think) Byass. Don't know much of her history. She had a half sister married, named Johnson, moved to Arkansas. Well, her family was reduced to her and her father. So they started South on horseback. I have seen the saddle and saddle bags many times. Fate or whatever you may call it caused our father and our mother to meet at Wetumpka, Alabama. Must have been love at first sight for I never learned much of their courtship, can't remember much about that. They married at Wetumpka, Dec. 6th. I am sure of that and must have been 1841 for I was born May 12, 1843. Don't know how long they lived at Wetumpka. They moved to Talladega County. I was born in Talladega County. Then we moved to Cherokee County is where I can just begin to remember things. I don't remember which County Aunt (his) Mollie was born in. Think was Talladega. Amanda was born in Cherokee,

Alabama. Sis was born Sept. 3, 1844, Amanda Feb. 2 or 14, I had it in my mind it was the 14th, but they say now that it was Feb. 2, 1847. In fall of 1849 we moved to Marshall County, Mississippi. On April 5, 1850 David was born. In 1851 we moved to Chilohoma. Moved to Larehoma in 1852, 1853 Wartha - I once had list but got burned at Great Springs - Next Ben, Henry, Lem, Andy, Mark was born March 20, 1853. Zeros next. Now I will leave the details for you or some other time. I can't follow Amanda's path after she was married, this is what I want of you -

I know of her being at the place Sam A at Tunnel and on the Dugger place and on Bers place and on place when Ben settled. But can't place them right, so will you tell me a person who owned the place when Ben owned. When Ben lived there and was there, anybody else besides Vaughn and me and Albert Dugger and Ben lived there before Ben. If so I can't remember who and that seems odd as I had share of the place after Hawkins left until Ben got it thru Dugger. My mind has got so dim. Will you have Etile learn of as much of her Mother's history as you can. I think that it was Wright Williams who married them but have lost the date. If the records are lost you might find it at the court House. We first moved the old place, Hawkins moved there. He lived in the old cabin in field. Now this is what has been on my mind and I can't get it straight. Was these houses where you lived occupied and by whom. They seemed better then where he lived. I remember helping you fix them. I remember now the road ran on north and seems there was some widow lived there. And what was the name of people that lived there before you. I remember Jess F and Ben Strance ----- But from the time I left there don't matter and it is only a whim that I thought you might help me out.

I will name one little item in my life - Grandfather Byass must have lived with us for awhile in Alabama after I was big enough to talk. Mother said he spoiled me to eat sugar and would tell of me going to sugar barrall and say big sugar, I wanted big lumps. Well, I love sugar yet.

And that brings to mind a small incident in my life. While a little child before we left Alabama, the picture of my Mother spinning and I and sis were playing near her. The thought had got into my mind that sometime we would see God. The question was "Me, who will get to see God?" Her answer and the sureness has never left me since - "I don't know honey, maybe those that are little children now." I have good hopes that I will live to see Christ appear. I have often wondered where that answer came from. Was it not the voice of God for she had not yet learned Gods plan of life as we know it now. But she surely lived a righteous life and was a noble Mother to us all.

About our name - Our forefathers were very strict to have it spelled ed Cooke and pronounced it Cook. Some would call it Cook but most of them would call it Cox. We were called Cox in Alabama, in Mississippi were called Cox. In Illinois, Arkansas, Indiana is called Cox. I always when asked for name would first spell it - spell it right and let them call it as they please.

NEWSMAKERS on page 716 contain an interesting account of the original Rockford, AL jail which was built about the time that my great-great grandfather, Absalom TERRELL moved from Carroll County GA to Coosa County, AL. It is now used as a museum.

The 1839 obituary about Mr. Henry Cocke is typical of those you are likely to find in early newspapers.

OUR FATHER'S FATHER.

November 24, 1914

My father, Henry Macon Cocke, was a son of Henry Cocke of North Carolina; the latter a school teacher and slave owner from a rich Virginia family. His riches were all spent before his family of 8 boys and 4 girls were raised. My father's mother's name was Mary. She was a zealous Christian and taught her children to be strict Depts. late.

My Mother, Eliza Jane Cocke was a daughter of Lucy Johnson & Peuben Bewless of Kentucky. When Mother was 15, she and her father went on horseback to Alabama, where Grandpa Bewless married again. By this time my Grandpa Cocke was dead and my Father had moved to Cherokee County, Alabama, where he met and married my Mother when she was 18 and he 30 or 32. My parents lived in Alabama until they had 4 children (I being born there Feb. 2, 1847) - the baby died there.

When I was three years old we moved to Mississippi. During this time Grandpa Bewless had moved to Arkansas and died leaving a wife and two or three boys. I never knew what became of them.

Father had a brother Thomas who also moved to Arkansas about the same time. He married and I think lived somewhere on the White River. We heard from him just after the war. He had three or four children. His girls were named Cora and Lucy. The old family pronounced Cocke as Cox, so if any of Uncle's children are living, they are likely known as Cox.

After we went to Mississippi my parents joined the Campbellites and soon after, some Christians (then called Thomesites) settled near us. Father was interested at once and when a short time later Dr. Thomas came through lecturing, Father left home, work, and a sick baby and went wherever the Doctor lectured as long as he remained in that part of the Country. He then secured and studied all the books he could find until he was satisfied the Kingdom would be set up on earth. Father and Mother were baptized at the same time. It was the first baptizing I remember. From that time until his death, Father's theme was "Christ is coming to rule the earth in righteousness." He lived to see all his children come into the truth except the baby who died. But one has turned from the truth and taken up other ways of the world. Many of my Father's grandchildren and three of his great grandchildren are following in his footsteps and still crying "Come, Lord Jesus, come quickly."

It was in 1850 that we moved to Mississippi. During the next ten years my Father changed from a Baptist to a "Wandering Jew." He and all of like faith were shut out of all church houses. It was then as now, all churches were afraid of a doctrine that would deprive the clergy of a salary. So the few (a dozen or two) who were studying and preparing to meet Christ at his coming, went from house to house each Sunday to read the Bible and break bread in memory of the absent Lord. These little bands always seemed to have a leader. So in this case a Dr. Webber of Pennsylvania came once in a while giving lectures and baptizing those who believed. All went well until the war. The Country divided, even families were hostile to each other, even preachers were not allowed to cross state lines, but the little band of be-

lievers kept up their meetings and the more distressing the times, the more they looked for Christ. Many of the young people had learned the truth and wanted to be baptized with no one available to do the baptizing. So after much talk and pleading, Father decided to baptize us. I was the third to be dipped in the water on Feb. 19, 1860. After this he baptized all who called on him until his sons were able to take his place.

At this time the South was almost crushed - the Country was full of guerillas and robbers and very unsafe for an honest man to travel. My Father was a Union man and only his age kept him from taking up arms against his country or leaving the State during the war as all white men in Mississippi between the ages of 18 and 55 had to join the Confederate Army or leave the State. When brother Will was 18, he went to work in an Emory, from there he was sent with a Company of Infantry to the battle of Corinth where he was taken prisoner. He was exchanged and sent back South. Was in Vicksburg where the prisoners almost starved before the Confederates surrendered. He came home on furlough, was not exchanged and was not allowed to stay home so he slipped off and went to Illinois where he remained for 18 months. Then he came home but he had learned to love some Illinois while there. Our Southern home was run over and torn up by both armies, so Father sold out and moved to Johnson County, Illinois where he still told of Christ and his coming until he had a few honest hearts listening to his story. We lived to see his children grown and to put on the name whereby we all must be saved. He helped to build a church house in Williamson County, Illinois, which was the first Christadelphian Church house to be built in the United States.

After moving to Illinois I made the acquaintance of Beverly Bredley who had just buried his wife and three children. He had two little girls, a little farm, a few sheep and a poor horse. He told me he had paid a hundred dollars interest on a hundred dollar note, that he could make money but could not save it and if I would save what he made we could make a living. I accepted his offer partly through sympathy for his children who needed a Mother. We were married October 19, 1871. To this union nine children were born - four girls and five boys. Ida Elizabeth born January 29, 1875 lived about nine months. Jasper Nelson born October 17, 1879 died January 24, 1894. Guy Beverly died October 30, 1912. My husband died March 27, 1913.

## Rockford Old rock jail has an interesting history

ROCKFORD — As visitors stroll through the old rock jail in Rockford, their thoughts roam back in several directions.

When the jail was built in 1842, by Miller and Herd contractors, the cost of \$2,745.00 was a far cry from what it would be today. Commissioner of Public Buildings at that time was William Campbell, and he reported on a job "well done."

Seeing as how it has lasted 144 years and six weeks (completion date was Aug. 13, 1842), it would seem that the commissioner was correct.

In 1867, A.E. Grady and wife, Sarah, contracted for an addition to the jail, with iron cages to be installed for \$3,100. For some reason, this latter contract was not fulfilled and the ironwork was later done by F.M. Thomason of Talladega, and it was completed in 1869.

Thomason was also engaged to complete the jail according to the original contract that had been entered into by the Grady's. A sum of \$200 was paid to Edward Kelly for rock work done on the jail.

The only hanging in the old jail occurred during W.M. Goggan's term as sheriff, and he took office in January 1811.

The executed man was Charlie White who was convicted for murdering Dock Maxwell. A man by the name of Logan was jailer, and Ebenezer Pond was county judge.

MANY REPORTS HAVE been handed down relating to that hanging. The sheriff's wife made the little black cap that was placed on White's head for execution, and got her husband to find out the prisoner's favorite food so she could prepare it for his last meal.

She also cried all day, so opposed was she to such an event.

When the sheriff came home, he told of the huge crowd present for the execution — coming by horseback, buggy and wagon and from all directions.

Charlie White had asked to be allowed to stand at the window — behind bars of course — and talk to the crowd. He told them that women and whiskey had put him where he was and for them not to blame the

sheriff for the hanging as he was simply doing his duty, as an officer.

The prisoner had been saving match heads, hoping to poison himself, but then felt that God had forgiven him of his sinful life and decided against his former plans.

He appealed to the large crowd to "meet me in Heaven." And all those present felt that the man was truly saved.

Today, the old jail serves an entirely different purpose. It has been converted into an interesting little museum, and Inez Warren — power behind the throne in Coosa County Historical Association — says "interest is increasing all the time, in the history of our area... and that is wonderful... we have a great county and we need to learn of its history... and its direction in the future."

IT WAS DECIDED sometime ago that if people had separate places to display their family memorabilia, they would take greater interest in such. The first need then was for several suitable glass cases, and Charles Thomas of Goodwater supplied the first of those.

The Egges family, also from Goodwater, have given extensive financial support to the museum, adds Mrs. Warren, "and all these gifts are surely appreciated."

Mr. and Mrs. Walter Dowdel of Goodwater have also made donations to the museum.

Volunteer help has been of inestimable value at the museum, says Mrs. Warren, such as Mrs. McGalliard in publishing the quarterly bulletin for the members.

Ben Carlton is president of Coosa County Historical Association and Mary George Teel is a charter member.

The idea of starting sales of Life Memberships for the museum — for \$100 — has attracted quite a lot of response, both from this area and elsewhere, it was pointed out.

Remodeling of the old jail two years ago was made possible by a grant from Housing and Urban Development. Rewiring and replastering were necessary, as well as replacing all grill work and installing a new roof.

Here again, there were "gifts of love" from many individuals who have close connections to the past in Coosa County, says Mrs. Warren.

Everyone is delighted that the place is now listed on the National Register of Historical Places.

Judge and Mrs. Mac Thomas supervised work from the first grant, and the late John Smith IV showed considerable interest in the museum, as have others.

The mere fact that the old jail has stood these 144 years, and was built with huge slabs of stone, make it a treasured landmark.

But add to that the varied history that has unfolded within these thick walls, and it becomes all the more important to protect and preserve the place for future generations.

As long as she is chairperson of improvements, Inez Warren intends to do just that!
