I found out who the Daniel L. Tyrrell from Martins Ferry, OH was related to. He was Daniel and Mary Ann Tyrrell's grandson. His parents were **William S.** and **Eliza Jane CUTSHAW TYRRELL**. William and Eliza were married in Belmont Co., OH on March 13, 1870. Her name was misspelled **KITZSHAW** in the marriage record. Daniel was born in Wegee, Belmont Co., OH on Jan. 25. His obituary gives the year as 1870, but his headstone says 1871. Daniel died Nov. 1, 1954 and was buried in Riverview Cemetery, Martins Ferry.

Eliza CUTSHAW Tyrrell married two more times. The second was to a man named **WISE**. There is no surviving record of their marriage nor do they appear in any census. SOME DESCENDANTS OF CAPT. WILLIAM A. TERRELL, SR.

1. Capt. William A. TERRELL, Sr. b. 1659 New Kent County, VA, d. AFT 1743 Hanover County, VA. William is the son of the immigrant, Sir Richmond TERRELL and his wife, Elizabeth; m. 1691 Susannah WATERS, b. ABT 1660 New Kent County, VA

"William TERRELL was living in the forks of the Pamunkey River in St. Paul's Parish, Honover County (VA), in January 1706. The church vestry appointed William HARRIS to be the surveyor of a new road in the forks, and William TERRELL, on the south side of the river, was ordered to assist him in clearing and making a road. The land between the North Anna and the South Anna rivers, near where they came together to form the Pamunkey, was often referred to as 'the Forks'.

William lived in the same area as Captain LITTLEPAGE, John BLALOCK, Edward GARLAND and Thomas CARR. Repeatedly, William's land was described as near the land of these neighbors, in the same precinct, in the processioning lists of St. Paul's Parish. It is believed that he continued to live on this same land, even though it is believed that it was he, who patented land in what was to become Caroline County (VA).

It appears to have been **William TERRELL**, **Sr.** who patented 300 acres of new land on the southwest side of Polecat Swamp in the county of King William. The following year he patented an additional 100 acres on the north side of the Pamunkey River in King William County; however, he did not cultivate this land. William continued to take up land around Polecat Swamp, acquiring 400 acres in 1716, and then in 1717, an additional 400 acres with his son, **William TERRELL (Jr.).** In January 1718, the records identify William as Senior, when he patented 229 acres on the Polecat. It was adjacent to the land he owned that was called 'Raven Neck' tract.

An additional 400 acres of land were awarded William on both sides of the north fork of Polecat Creek, also in 1718. These all appear to be patents that can be identified as those of William TERRELL, Sr. From the descriptions of the land, there do not appear to be any re-patents of the same land. In all, just the land patents in the Polecat Creek area amounted to 1,820 acres. There is no record of how much land he owned in St. Paul's Parish in Hanover County.

At that time, settlement was encouraged in the King William-Caroline County frontier. It is said that the settlers were awarded 50 acres for each child that they claimed. William acquired a reputation of having eighteen children in ten years when someone later totaled his acreage in land patents. He appears to have taken up considerably more land than that, which stretches the credence of the observation on two counts.

It seems that William continued to live in St. Paul's Parish, so it is likely that it was his son, **William (Jr.)**, who established himself in the newly created St. Margaret's Parish in Caroline County. A number of the children of **William (Sr.)** were later to live in the same area, so it appears that his land went to his sons and daughters.

There does not appear to be conclusive evidence as to the ancestry of William TERRELL. There are many TERRELL descendants scattered throughout the United States and a number of family histories have been compiled. Some were undertaken at early dates, and the compilers did not have the benefit of more recent extensive research. The latest, and it seems, the most authoritative, has been written by **Emma Dicken**. She has corrected some earlier misconceptions and has provided some good insight as to the origins and the relationships of the early TERRELLs. By her own admission, some of the relationships cannot be documented, and family tradition is the only source of information available."

"No reference has been found which documents the relationship of father and son between **Richmond I** and **William TER-RELL**. It is generally accepted, within the TERRELL family, that William was the son of Richmond 1. Other sons were **Timothy** and **Richmond II**, who patented the new land in Hanover County (VA) in 1732. Both were in Hanover County (VA) at the same time that William lived there. A tradition handed down among the descendants of several branches of the **Joel TER-RELL** family (a son of **William**) has claimed **Richmond I**, as the ancestor of Joel."

"Family tradition has always passed down the information that **William** married **Susannah WATERS**. The wife of **William** was named **Susannah**, as she was identified in a document granting her power of attorney to her son, **Henry**, to relinquish her dower, when she and William deeded land on Polecat Swamp, in March 1725, to their son, **David**.

No conclusive information as to her maiden name has been found in the available records. It is known that **William** had sons, **David** and **Henry**, and a son, **William** (**Jr.**). **Joel** (**TER-RELL**)'s grandson recounted in his family history that William TERRELL was the father of **Joel**, and that Joel had brothers, **James**, **John** and **Timothy**.

It is said that **Anne**, the daughter of William and Susannah, married **David LEWIS**. While the name of Mary TERRELL has not been found in any of the records, there can be little doubt

that she, too, was the daughter of William and Susannah. The account of the life of **Micajah CHILES** discusses this fully.

The lives of **Micajah** and his wife, **Mary**, and later, Mary and her second husband, **Matthew MILLS**, were so completely intertwined with the lives of **David** and **Henry TERRELL** that there can be little doubt of this relationship. Matthew and Mary named a son **William Terrell MILLS**. Micajah CHILES owned land adjoining the land of **William TERRELL** and **Joel TERRELL** of Polecat Creek.

William TERRELL, or his son, William (Jr.), continued to buy land as late as March 1773, when he bought land from Ephraim Richard LITTLEPAGE adjoining John GIBSON and a little below the fork of the river next to land of Richard HARRIS. The land of William TERRELL was ordered processioned on November 18, 1743. This was the last mention of his name and his land in St. Paul's Parish in Hanover County (VA).

William must have died not too long after the 1743 processioning order. There are no Hanover County court records extant for that period, so his exact death date has not been found. The Henrico Monthly Meeting of the Society of Friends identified Henry TERRELL in their minutes on April 3, 1744, as being the son of William TERRELL, deceased, of Hanover County. Since Susannah had a number of children living in Caroline County (VA) at that time, she may have gone to live with one of them in the Polecat Creek area.

William and Susannah had many grandchildren. In all, they must have had at least nine children, who lived to adulthood and all of their children had several children. The TERRELL descendants migrated to the South, to North Carolina; and to the west, first as far as Campbell County and Lynchburg (VA), then over the mountains."

The above is reprinted as it appeared in the book, *TIDEWATER VIRGINIA FAMILIES*, by **Virginia Lee Hutcheson Davis**, pages 267-269, published by Genealogical Publishing Co., Inc., 1001 N. Calvert Street, Baltimore, MD 21202-3809. The book attempts to give an accounting of William TERRELL, his father, Richmond, and his sons and grandsons. The author, Davis, gives a good accounting of references in the book to verify her data.

Another publication gave one slight variation in the children in that it listed a **John** but no **David**. There is always the possibility that the child was named **John David TERRELL**, but there is no evidence of that.

This latter publication had one major difference. It listed William as William TERRELL II and his father as William TYRRELL. It also noted that "the name prior to coming to Virginia was TYRRELL but after the migration it was changed to TERRELL."

His father and mother deeded 400 acres of land in St. Margaret's Parish, King William County (VA), to on March 16, 1725. David settled on that land in the Polecat Creek area, near what was to become Caroline County (VA) and Golansville. It was the same area in which a large group of Quakers settled, and David embraced the faith. He married Agatha CHILES, the daughter of Henry CHILES of St. Paul's Parish, Hanover County (VA). The first mention of David in the minutes of the Cedar Creek Monthly Meeting was his attendance at a marriage in the First Month 1739, when he signed a marriage certificate. David became increasingly active in the Society and was one of the men who bought the land for the Golansville Meeting House. He contributed money and his energies to the Quaker community and had property seized on several occasions for not paying the proscribed parish levy and for not attending militia meetings. In 1752, he became the overseer of the Cedar Creek Meeting.

Some of the children of David and Agatha "remained faithful to their Quaker heritage and some did not. In December 1757, **Agatha** openly declared that she was not one of the Quakers. David died by April 12, 1759, as his will was recorded on that date in Caroline County. He named all of his children except **Susannah** and **Jonathan**. They were born after their father had made his will in 1751. They were later provided for in the will of their uncle, **Henry TERRELL**. Agatha was appointed the guardian of **Rachel**, **Chiles** and **Christopher**, who were still under age. Agatha died before November 1775, when the settlement of her estate was noted in the Caroline County court records."

Please note that the will mentioned in the publication varies slightly from the information I received from an earlier source in that it lists the twins as Simon and Aaron (no dates), whereas my earlier source carried the twins as Moses and Aaron, born in December 1755. Other variations were the spelling of the names, though they were all very close in similarity, such as Milly rather than Millie and Richmond rather than Richard. Jane GIFFIN; James, 1770, d. 1790; Jeremiah, 1773, d. 1855 in Belleville IL; Ruth, d. 1805, md. Bradway DAVIS; Newcomb, 1778, later life not known; Mary, 1781, md. Ephraim MAGEE; and Phoebe Prudence who d. young. Phoebe may have been the child of his second marriage to Phoebe Garrison [THOMPSON?/VanHORN?]. Adam served in the NJ Militia during the Revolutionary War. He d. 1790. I have no way of knowing if either is still at that address.]
