We have to mail at least 66 free copies of each issue to qualify for bulk mail minimum of 200 pieces per mailing. Our current active and lifetime membership has dwindled to where we would almost break even using first class and mailing no promotional free copies to libraries and archives.

Having to make 66 less copies of each issue would result in a savings of \$84.74 on Spring/Summer and \$84.74 on Fall/Winter at our 2009 rates. That is \$169.48 per year reduction in copy costs.

* This loss occurred when we changed from 3-ring binding to plastic spine binding. The cost was for equipment and supplies. Also I copy books in large enough quantities to get the minimum cost per impression. Years with higher figures were due in part to shipping books that I copied the previous year.

We have always operated on a non-profit basis. Whatever we received has been used toward the goals of the Society. Thanks to you, our Library has more than broken even over all.

POSSIBLE CHANGES IN 2010

The only change I intend to make (unless the other officers direct me to do otherwise before December 2009) is from <u>bulk mail to first class mail</u> for *Terrell Trails*. As you can see from the comparison in this issue, our membership has dwindled to a break-even point in postage costs.

This is a collection of ideas for your consideration.

1. Establish an e-commerce web site (either our present one or a new one) depending upon costs and volunteer(s) willing to maintain the site.

- 2. Make all publications available through the sight to everyone. This would include not only the volumes in the **Lending Library**, but also *Terrell Trails*.
- 3. Membership is limited to those "who descended from, or may have descended from, those who migrated here from England or elsewhere in Europe" by our Articles of Incorporation. To open up membership to all with an interest in the surname would require the expense of amending the Articles of Incorporation, well over \$100.00. However, dues are determined by the By-Laws with membership approval. Our dues structure might be amended to allow lower dues for members who can and will accept Terrell Trails as an e-text, either attached to an e-mail or downloaded from our web site. For example only: dues to receive a printed copy of Terrell Trails, the current \$20.00; dues to members who either accept e-text or do not want Trails, \$10.00 per year. In that way, we can continue to serve our members who are not online and offer a little toward the expenses incurred by those who are online.
- 4. Reduce the number of pages in Terrell Trails to a number that will result in the most efficient use of postage. Our Articles of Inc. state that we will have a quarterly newsletter with a minimum of 4 pages. At first we printed whatever our budget would mail. We never fell to the minimum in any year. Any reduction in the number of pages will result in that much less information being distributed to members.

In this census, Joseph is living almost adjacent (pp. 933-934) to William TERRELL, age 30, b. Ga. I know this person to be William George TERRELL b. 1830 in Ga. At first impression, these would seem to be brothers, but I cannot find any proof, and so I am wondering if they are cousins. William George TERRELL was the son of William Coleman and Mary McManus and was probably born as William TERRELL Ford. He took the surname of his great-grandfather William TERRELL (b. 1760 Lancaster Co, S.C.; d. 1851 Dekalb Co, Ga.), a Revolutionary War veteran. This William George TERRELL is not (yet) known to have had any brother named Joseph.

Also in Randolph Co, Ala., in 1850 we find William FORD hiding out in that county from a murder indictment back in At-

lanta (Fulton Co), Ga. By 1851 he will change his name to **William George TERRELL** (the man I have identified above) and be mentioned in his great-grandfather's 1851 will. We find also in Randolph Co **James HENSON** and wife "**Celia**." Celia is actually "**Selita TERRELL**," daughter of **William TERRELL** (the Revolutionary soldier) and also mentioned in that will.

So, **Doctor Franklin TERRELL** is the son of **William Richard TERRELL**, and **William Richard TERRELL** is the son of **Joseph TERRELL**, and Joseph is definitely part of the TERRELL clan whose earliest origins are traced to John TERRELL and his sons William (the Revolutionary soldier) and Richmond TERRELL.

If you can figure out how Joseph connects to William George TERRELL, I would certainly like to hear from you.

Sorry that I cannot identify his ancestry; however, I can tell you that James is also found in the 1900 census of Iberville Parish, La., at ED 15, S 8, L 97 with his wife and children.

Your data is interesting. I used the LDS 1880 census which is an indexed transcript, and I did not find the 1880 entry for this family.

There are two other TERRELL families living in Iberville Parish. Both are known to me and I cannot seem to connect either with James. Also, James is not really living sufficiently close to them to cause me to strongly suspect a relationship.

I have searched 1860 and 1870, but can't find anyone who I suspect to the James.

My data on the 1900 census is incomplete, since it comes only from the SOUNDEX index card rather than from the entire census page:

William C. JONES, b. 1805, Henry Co., KY, the son of Israel JONES and Margaret CONNER. Israel Jones was born in Virginia, and at an early age moved to Kentucky and resided there until 1825, when he went to Weakley Co., Tenn., and was one of the few men who assisted in making the first settlements.

William C. JONES married Dec. 24, 1839 to Mrs. Vaginia BONDURANT Bayliss, b. 1814 in Kentucky.

Soon after his marriage, William bought property near Dresden. His wife died on Oct. 19, 1857 and in Dec. 1858, he married **Sarah BONDURANT**, b. in 1828, dau. of **Hillery BONDURANT** and **Unity TERRELL**. William and Sarah had 2 children: **Hillary B. JONES** and **Maggie JONES** (Mrs. **E. J. White** of Ft. Worth, Texas).

Unity TERRELL's father, **John TERRELL**, was the original owner of the land on which the town of Dresden sits on. He was one of Weakley County's original settlers and lived for some time where the courthouse now stands (1887) and afterwards where the W. C. Scott home is now (1887). The first court ever held in Weakley County was held in John TERRELL's sheep pen.

William C. Jones died March 1886. He owned about 1,000 acres, left his family in good financial circumstances. Wife and son, Hillary, lived on the home place. William was a Democrat and a Presbyterian.

J. M. TERRELL was initiated, passed and raised to a Master Mason in 1878 (In other words. he joined in that year.) in Theodocia (Note that your person had the wrong spelling) Lodge 182 located in Sarepta, Calhoun Co., Mississippi. That lodge was chartered on 1/16/1854 and ceased to exist 4/24/36. That is all that I have other than a list of members. I found no other TERRELL in that lodge.

Gene, there was a **John Thomas TERRELL**, b. c. 1842/43 who left Military schools (doesn't say where) to join the CSA, killed by a sniper's bullet Aug. 22, 1864, Atlanta. He was a son to the **Blair Moorman TERRELL**, b. 2/16/1816, Campbell Co., VA., to parents **John Pleasant TERRELL** and **Martha MOOR-MAN**. Blair M. married **Elvira Naomi GREENWOOD** Quincy area and Blair was a large land owner, planter. John Thomas is listed as their first child. Other sons listed are:

William was the son of Richmond TERRELL (b. 1624, Reading, England; d. ca. 1677-83, New Kent Co, Va.) and Elizabeth (WATERS?).

Emma Dicken, in her book Terrell Genealogy (ca. 1952), discusses the disagreement over whether this William was the son of Richmond TERRELL or the brother of Richmond TERRELL (indeed, Richmond did have a brother named William). She concluded from the dates and circumstances that William was the son. I normally scout the TERRELL bulletin boards looking for TERRELL data; however, I accidentally found your January 2000 bulletin on the Cleburne Co, Ala., bulletin board.

- 2. After his discharge (1836) he lived in Decatur, DeKalb Co., Ga. for 16 years (to 1852?), at Wedowee (Randolph Co.), Ala. for 4 years (to 1858?), back to DeKalb Co., Ga. for 17 years (to 1875) and Edwardsville, Ala. to 1892+.
- 3. As of 1836 Joseph appeared as follows: 5' 9", blue eyes, black hair, light complexion. Occupation: Farmer.
- This may by the same Joseph TERRELL who appears briefly on the rolls of Co. B, Capt. S.A. Moses' Sqdn. Ala. Cav. CSA. Enlisted at Wedowee, Ala. in Mar 1864 and discharged on 15 Jul 1864.
- 5. As of 1892 he was living at Edwardsville, Zedonia, Cleburne Co., Ala.
- This man is undoubtedly part of the TERRELL family of Lancaster Co., S.C. which was described in TERRELL Trails, Fall 1989, pp. 398-405; but it is not clear who were his parents.

As described above, I believe this man to be part of the Lancaster Co, S.C. clan. But how does he fit? In the 1860 census he is living as a close neighbor of **William George TERRELL** (1830-?), who was great-grandson **of William TERRELL** (1760-1851, DeKalb Co, Ga.) (formerly of Lancaster Co) and mentioned in his will as "William TERRELL alias William TERRELL Ford."

William Sr.'s father was **John TERRELL**, and William's brother was **Richmond TERRELL** (1755-ca. 1805). They are all believed to be descended from **Richmond TERRELL** of New Kent Co, Va. (b. 1626, England). How they are connected has not yet been discovered.

William Sr.'s line is also a mess. From his will, it appears that he had no male heirs, yet we have a William George TER-RELL. The story, long forgotten seems to involve the child of a TERRELL woman and a FORD man. The father was sent to prison or executed for a murder, and the child is given the name ____ TERRELL. I show the father to be William FORD and the mother to be (Mary TERRELL?). But other researchers say that I have misunderstood the relationship. And some of the

Thanks for the information. My husband's lineage goes through William Peter youngest brother of Eli. Why did William George go by the name of TERRELL instead of FORD?

The story as it is told by a granddaughter of **William Peter** goes that the **Ford** man was either sent to prison or otherwise disappeared and **Matilda** died when "**Billy**" was very young. "**Billy**" was then taken by his maternal grandparents (**William** and **Unknown**) and they raised him. When he was 21 his TERRELL grandfather gave him the choice of legally becoming a TERRELL or a FORD and he chose his mother's name, TERRELL. Before the war, Billy and Mariah owned a mercantile store at

Before the war, Billy and Mariah owned a mercantile store at Little Five Points in DeKalb, GA. The family also owned land around Grants Park (in Atlanta, GA) which was later lost in a land dispute in which the FORD family played a part.

When the war came, **Billy** became a confederate soldier. Later when rumors came that *Sherman* was going to burn Atlanta, **Mariah** moved her family to Carroll Co. **Billy** survived the war and is buried with Mariah at Oak Grove Baptist Church Cemetery in Carroll Co., but markers for the graves has long disappeared.

Please advise what would be the best route for me to follow to find information on **Elizabeth TERRELL**, born abt. 1735/40, married 5 Sep 1754 in Chowan County, North Carolina, to **John "Renta" BAKER**. I've tried LDS, the internet and family notes, but no record concerning her parents.

She seems to fit best to **Joseph TERRILL**, born 16 Nov 1699, son of **Timothy TERRILL** and **Elizabeth FOSTER** or with **James TERRELL**, born abt 1702, son of **William TERRELL** and **Susannah WATERS**. Unfortunately, I find no record of a daughter born to either of these men. Family notes indicate that she was somehow related to **Obediah TERRELL**, which seems logical since **Obediah** and **John "Renta" BAKER** went on hunting expeditions together. I have run across the published research of other persons who are likewise stuck at **John BAKER** and **Elizabeth TERRELL**. I have tried, but failed, to connect Elizabeth to the identified Terrell clan. The problem being that these are late colonial records, and there have been too many courthouse fires over the centuries.

The **Joseph TERRILL**, to whom you refer would be about is a candidate because so very little is known about him. If he had daughters, there is no record. We do know that his son William was still in Bedford Co, Va., in 1780 because that is where he married. This hints that the family stayed in Virginia, but proves nothing.

James TERRELL, whom you mentioned, had a daughter named **Elizabeth**, but I credit her as marrying **Giles NEWTON** about 1759 in Va., and then settling somewhere around Henrico or Caroline counties and having at least six children before her death in Marlboro Co, S.C. sometime after 1767 (the birth of her last recorded child). The reason for my question is Mildred Lykens and I have discovered that **Charles P. TIRRELL** was married three times.

We haven't figured out who she was at the moment. But we do know that Charles 2nd wife was **Sarah** (last name unknown for the moment) and she is the mother of **Flora E. TIRRELL Crum**. Sarah is not the mother of **Francis O., Elijah L., Nancy**, or **Susan**, the first wife is. The third wife was **Eva KISSIN-GER** (no children from this marriage; he was 73 & she was in her 30's). I have no idea who those TERRELLS are.

First thing that struck me as odd is the listed birthplace of Charles. Letcher County is as far east as one can go in KY. Generally the migration pattern was either south or west. There have been few recorded instances of descendants going either south or west and then returning north or east.

The second question that arises is who were the older children: William...age 13...Kentucky; Ruben...age 10...Kentucky; & Aron...age 9...Kentucky? The 1870 census did not show relationships. Charles & Louisa would have been about 19 and 15 respectively when William was born. Fifteen was not too early an age for a girl to begin a family in that era. However, the man had to be the provider for the family and rarely married or started families before their mid twenties.

This raises questions: 1) were these brothers or sisters of either Charles or Louisa; 2) were they Louisa's by a previous spouse; or 3) were they nephews or otherwise associated with Charles & Louisa?

Finally, does the ages (Francis...age 3...Kentucky...(listed as a female); & Nancy...age 1...Kentucky) fit the right time frame to be your Francis & Nancy? The names Francis & Frances were spelled in that era at the discretion of the writer. The "i" and the "e" were not used to denote sex as much as they are today.

I am sending a copy of this to Don C. Terrill. He may have already connected this family with someone.

I find Charles and family appearing only in the 1870 census, and no other. Internet data posted by Randy & Tina TIRRELL (probably the writer) says that **Charles TIRRELL** is descended from **James, Amos, Gideon Jr., Gideon I,** and **William THERREL**. This spelling and first names VERY strongly suggests that Charles is a New England Terrell (whom I have not researched) and that "Miss." (As it actually appears on the census book) is really "Mass." Also, the spelling "TIRRELL" is virtually unknown in the 19th century (and earlier) South.

As a long shot I will suggest he is **Charles P. TIRRELL**, b. 13 Dec 1837 in Plainfield, Mass. He was the adopted son of **James TIRRELL** and **Clarissa BIRD**. He disappears from the record and his fate is not known. (*The Tirrell, Tirrill-Terrill, Tyrrell Book, Descendants of William Therrill*, by Robert Wilson TIRRELL [Deford & Co, Baltimore, Md.: 1969], Lib. Cong. CS72.T3 1969, pp. 119, 208). Perhaps the author never searched Kentucky. Or else, he found the "Miss." birthplace (as we did) and dismissed this person as the same Charles P. TIRRELL. Don C. I regret that I cannot answer your question. From the time period and location it is possible that she was a descendant of either

Roger TERRILL & Abigail UFFORD, or of William THERRELL & Rebecca SIMPKINS (m. 1654). Roger arrived in Boston 1632, married, and settled in New Milford, CT. William arrived about the same time and settled in Boston, MA. Descendants of both couples lived and migrated in the same general. However, it is also possible that she descended from those below.

According to *The TIRRELL-TIRRILL-TERRILL-TYRRELL BOOK*, Second ed., 1969, by Robert Wilson Tirrell of NJ, p. 5 there was also one **Daniel TURRELL** in Boston ca1640 from Instow, Devonshire, [England] according to "Savage" & "Banks." (Whomever they may be).

There was also one **John TURRELL** in Boston ca1640 also from Instow according to a Power of Attorney dated 1711 wherein **John TURRELL** of Instow, eldest son and heir of **Samuel TURRELL**, deceased, only son of **John TURRELL**, late of Boston, and **William TURRELL** of New England sell land situated at corner of Cross and Hanover Streets in Boston. This is not likely to be **William THERRELL** above because he d. 1682. **Susannah** may have been a descendant of this 1711 William. But this family is not covered in the book. According to Tirrell, it is likely that John and Daniel were related, but "Instow records have been searched and no evidence has been found relating to these men, although the TURRELL name is found in the Churchyard at Instow."

George is descended from a family which originally spelled the last name as TERRAL, and first appears in surviving records in 1737 when the earliest (William) petitioned for land in South Carolina.
